A. CALL TO ORDER

1. Bliss called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and took the roll call. Bliss read the statement regarding the Open Meetings Act. Pursuant to Section 84-1412 (8) of the Nebraska Open meetings Act, a current copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted in the entry of this meeting room and is available for viewing by the public.
2. Motion to convene: Steinmeyer motioned to convene; Renn seconded. By roll call, the vote was 3 – “yes” (Steinmeyer, Brown, Renn)/0 – “no”. Motion passed.

B. CURRENT BUSINESS

1. Approve minutes from July 12, 2021 CAR meeting – Members reviewed minutes from previous meeting. Steinmeyer motioned to approve minutes from the July 12, 2021 CAR meeting as presented; Brown seconded. By roll call, the vote was 3 – “yes” (Steinmeyer, Brown, Renn)/0 – “no”. Motion passed.
2. Review 2020 LB840 Activities for July 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021 – Activities discussed. Bliss called for a motion on the review of 2021 LB840 activities for the reporting period. Steinmeyer motioned to recommend ending the COVID gift card multiplier and accepting the LB840 Activities for the period June 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021 as presented; Renn seconded. By roll call, the vote was 3 – “yes” (Steinmeyer, Brown, Renn)/0 – “no”. Motion passed.
3. The Committee reviewed the City of Fairbury’s Economic Development LB840 plan as it is currently written. While the City wants to encourage accountability and transparency, public hearings generate additional expenses. Following conversation, Steinmeyer motioned to recommend eliminating any public hearing requirements that are not required by Nebraska State Statute; Renn seconded. By roll call, the vote was 3 – “yes” (Steinmeyer, Brown, Renn)/0 – “no”. Motion passed. Messbarger and Bliss will follow-up with the City of Fairbury’s city attorney to determine what public hearing steps can be eliminated.
