

FAIRBURY PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE

MINUTES

July 5th, 2022
7:00 p.m.

Member Rogge made the statement regarding the Open Meetings Act as required by statute.

1. Member Phil Rogge called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and asked for roll call. Other members present were: Brian Schmidt, Tim Polson and Kelly Davis.

2. Next, was the motion to convene.

Member Davis made the motion to convene. Member Schmidt seconded the motion. By roll call, the vote was 4 - "yes" (Schmidt, Rogge, Polson and Davis) / 0 - "nay". The motion passed.

3. Next, was the approval of the May 17th, 2022, minutes. Discussion, taking of any necessary or desired action.

Next, was discussion and recommendation regarding a request from Fairbury Area Girls Softball Association and Tooley's Bar to place barricades in the 300 block of D Street directly south of 4th Street and directly north of the east and west alley between 3rd and 4th Streets on D Street for a cornhole tournament and beer garden on July 24th from 9 a.m. to 1 a.m. Discussion, taking of any necessary or desired action.

Development Services Director Bedlan referred the commission to the memo in the packet and explained the request noting that Lori Ohlde from the softball association and Abbey Hasselbring with Tooley's bar were present to answer any questions. Ohlde explained the need for fundraising and the schedule for the street closing. Hasselbring explained that the street closing will be the same as was done previously for other events except that they are proposing to fence up to the front of the building and have a bouncer at the door of the bar to monitor drinks that leave the bar and enter the beer garden.
