



H Street Reconstruction Project Fact Sheet

1. How is this project being financed?
 - a. No special assessment will be necessary. The City has worked with our municipal financial advisor and bond counsel to be able to pay for the project with existing revenues.
2. What is the proposed timeline for the project?
 - a. The project will go to bid late this year/early next year. Construction is anticipated to begin next spring and the entire project will take approximately 6 months to complete. However, access to your property will not be limited during the entire project.
 - b. The project will be constructed in phases. Each construction phase is estimated to last 6 weeks. The City will work with the selected contractor to organize the project in the most efficient manner. Once the contractor is selected residents will be invited to another meeting to discuss phasing.
3. What about my landscaping and underground irrigation?
 - a. Any landscaping removed will be replaced by the contractor with a similar species and quantity to the satisfaction of the homeowner. All grass areas disturbed by construction will be re-seeded. Underground irrigation will also be replaced by the contractor to the satisfaction of the homeowner.
4. What about my driveway?
 - a. Driveway surfaces will have to be removed during construction; however, they will be replaced by the contractor.
5. Where will I park?
 - a. During your respective construction phase, residents will have to find alternative places to park their vehicles. This could be side streets, rear yards via alley access, etc.
6. What about my trash?
 - a. The City will work with the selected contractor to organize a community collection site per construction phase.
7. What about my mail service?
 - a. The City and the selected contractor will work with the United States Postal Service to organize a collection site per construction phase. However, postal service operations will be at the sole discretion of USPS.
